gravel.

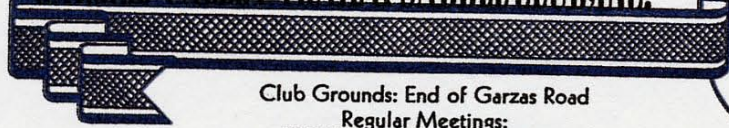
Paul Parter gave the Treasurer's
